Hon. Agni Deo Singh was born in Labasa, where he also completed his primary and secondary education. He obtained his Primary Teaching Certificate from Corpus Christi College and earned a Diploma and Degree in Education from the University of the South Pacific (USP).

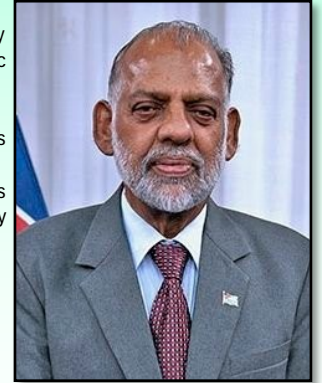
Hon. Singh has further qualifications including a Diploma in Industrial Relations (Geneva), a Diploma in International Labour Standards (Italy), a Diploma in Co-operative Management (Israel), and a Diploma in Human Resource Management (Malaysia).

In 1999, he was appointed General Secretary of the Fiji Teachers Union until 2022, when he resigned to join politics. He has served as Chairman of the Fiji Teachers Union Co-operative Thrift & Credit Ltd since 1996, spanning more than two decades. He also played a key role in the establishment of the Fiji Teachers Union Self-Funding Medical Coverage Plan.

Hon. Singh has served on several boards and committees, including:

- Education International Asia Pacific Region (Executive Board Member)
- Fiji Teachers Registration Authority (Board Member)

- University of Fiji (Council Member since inception)
- USP School of Humanities (Deputy Chair, Programme Advisory Committee)

A strong trade unionist and advocate for workers' rights, Hon. Singh served as a Member of Parliament from April to December 2006. Currently, he is the Minister for Employment, Productivity and Workplace Relations.
